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## HEADLINES

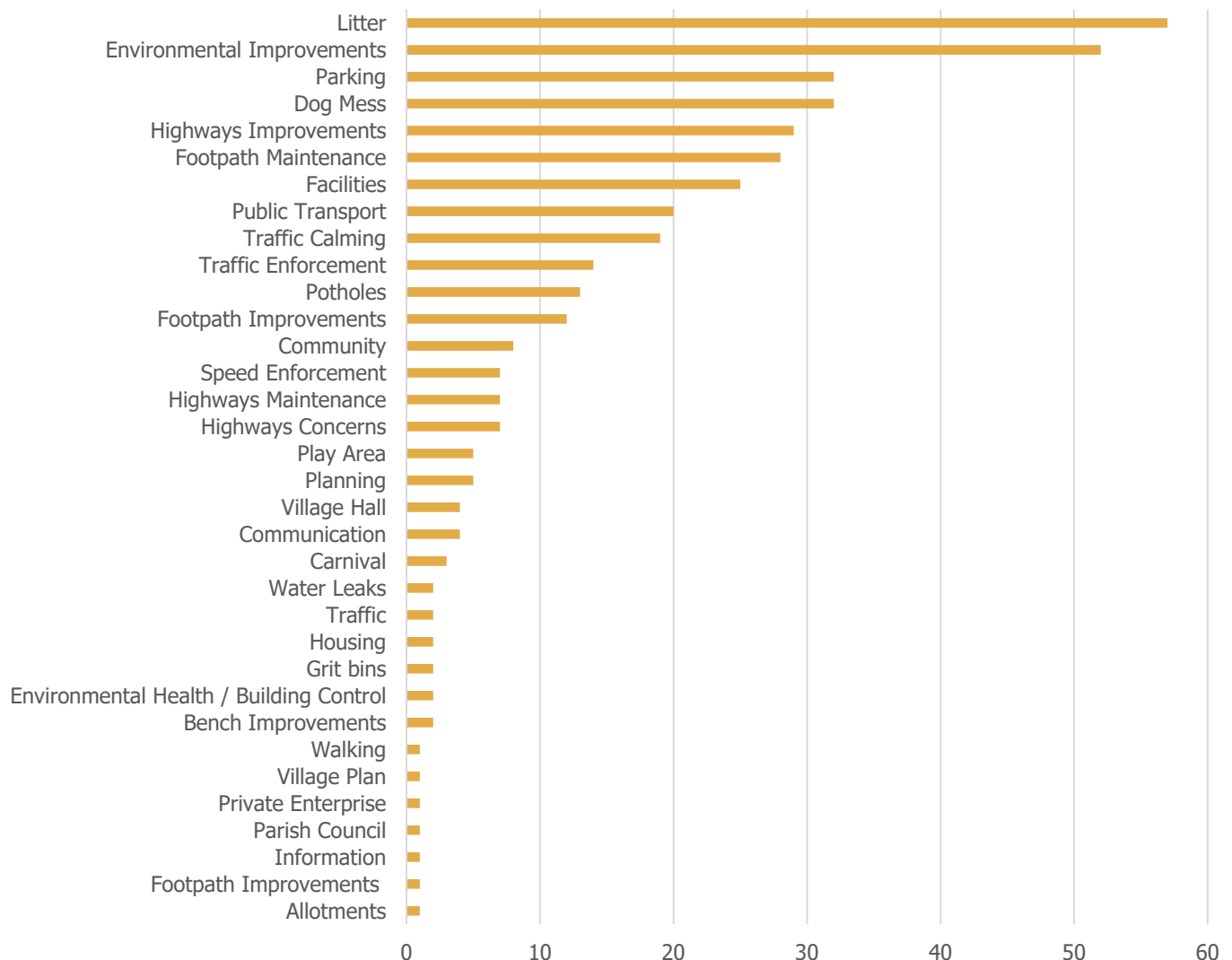
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- 138 responses received, providing a return rate of 17.78% (776 households in the parish with registered electors).
- Residents who have lived in the village for over 20 years make up the majority of respondents.
- Respondents overall have a:
  - Positive view on the quality of life, community facilities, and community activities within the village.
  - Negative view on the cleanliness and tidiness of the village.
  - Tending positive view on the play park.
- Villagers are not sure whether the Parish Council provides value for money. The Parish Council has a challenge to visibly demonstrate how it provides value for money.
- The priority issues for villagers from the Quantitative Analysis are:
  - Improving Public Transport
  - Improving Traffic Calming Measures
  - Improving Facilities and Activities for Young People, and
  - Improving the Appearance of the Village.
- From the Qualitative Analysis, the key emerging themes are:
  - Improving Litter within the Village
  - Improving the Environment, through Litter Picking, reducing Dog Mess and providing visual improvements to the village
  - Improving Parking Provision
  - Improving the Highways
  - Maintaining Footpaths
- Of the areas identified in the Qualitative Analysis, 195 are the responsibility of Cumberland Council, with 113 being the responsibility of the Parish Council.
- The key areas that could result in the greatest impact, within the purview of the Parish Council, are:
  - Recruiting a Village Handyman to improve the environment of the village and maintain paths.
  - Organising Community Litter Picks
  - Improving Facilities for Young People, and the Play Park
  - Improving Village Amenities through Tree Planting and New Benches
  - Improving the Derelict Telephone Box on Main Street
  - Improving Communications with Villagers.

# BROUGHTON PARISH SURVEY QUANTATIVE DATA RESULTS

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## HEADLINES

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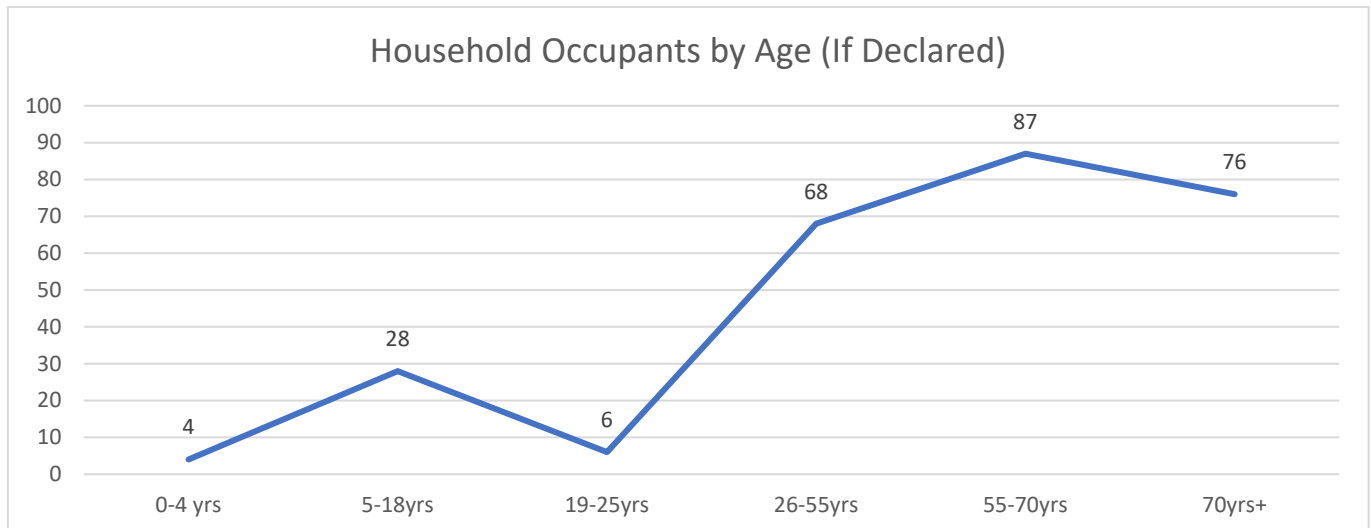
- These Results include analysis of the quantitative data obtained from the recent Parish Survey. The qualitative results will require deeper analysis prior to them being ready for issue.
- 138 responses received, providing a return rate of 17.78% (776 households in the parish with registered electors).
- Residents who have lived in the village for over 20 years make up the majority of respondents.
- Respondents overall have a:
  - Positive view on the quality of life, community facilities, and community activities within the village.
  - Negative view on the cleanliness and tidiness of the village.
  - Tending positive view on the play park.
- Villagers are not sure whether the Parish Council provides value for money. The Parish Council has a challenge to visibly demonstrate how it provides value for money.
- The priority issues for villagers are:
  - Improving Public Transport
  - Improving Traffic Calming Measures
  - Improving Facilities and Activities for Young People, and
  - Improving the Appearance of the Village.
- Whilst Public Transport and Traffic Management are not the responsibility for the Parish Council, these findings can be relayed to the local Cumberland Councillor for Dearham and Broughton for information.
- The Parish Council can directly influence improving provision of facilities for young people and improving the appearance of the village.
- Medium priority issues are Improving Facilities and Activities for Older People and Improving the Play Area on the Welfare Field.
- Respondents with household members under 18, that improving the Play Area is rated at 55% Extremely Important and 36% Very Important, but this accounts for only 11 responses of the 138 received.
- Once the qualitative results of comments and suggestions made are processed, this will provide significant additional insights of the views of villagers.

## Health Warning

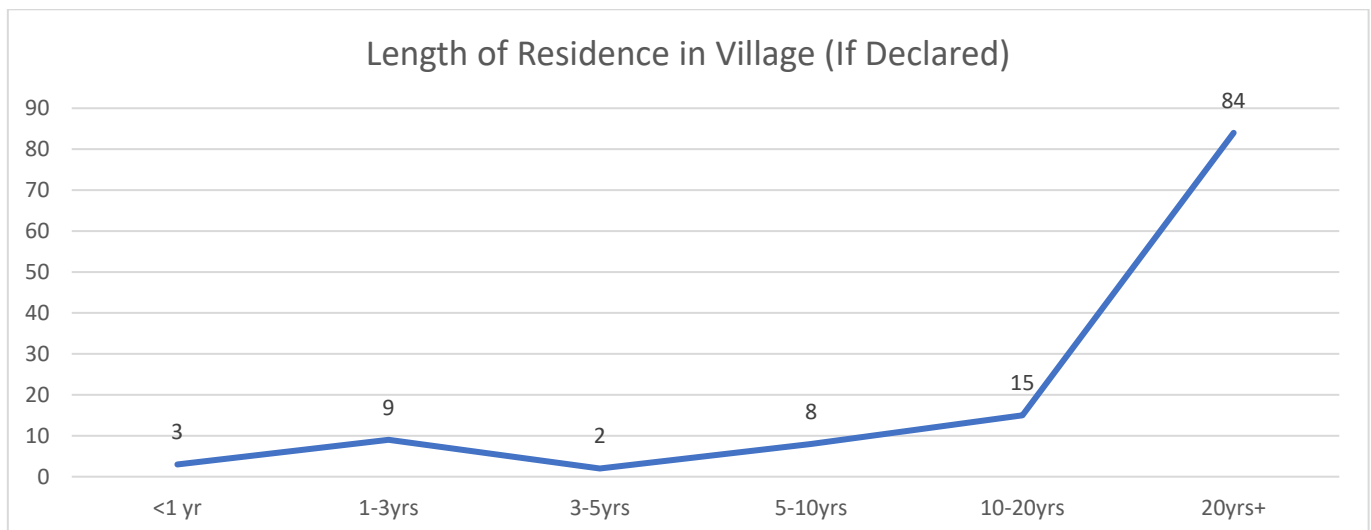
- Given the significant bias in age demographic of respondents, and that the survey was not conducted as a random stratified sample, the results are indicative but not necessarily representative of the population of the village as a whole.

## ABOUT YOU AND YOUR HOUSEHOLD

- Respondents declared the number of household occupants and their ages within given bandings. Of the 138 responses, 5 did not complete this question.
- The significant proportion of households which completed the survey included persons over the age of 55, which does not wholly reflect the age distribution of village residents when compared to census data.



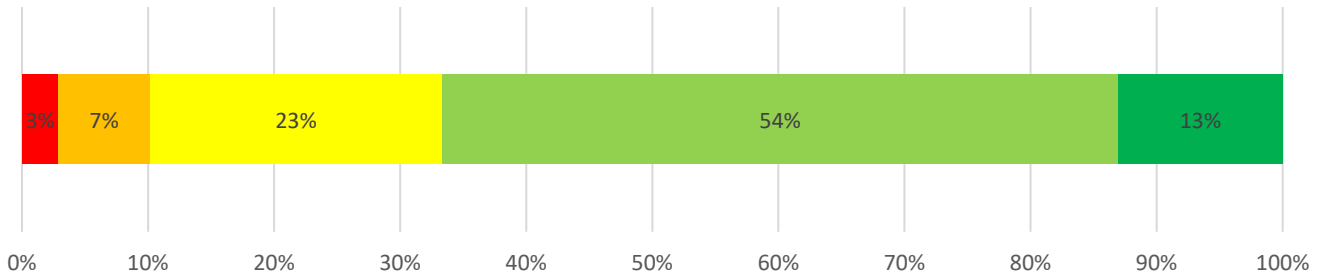
- Respondents declared how long they have lived in the village. Of the 138 responses, 22 did not complete this question.
- The significant proportion of households which completed the survey have lived in the village for over 20 years.



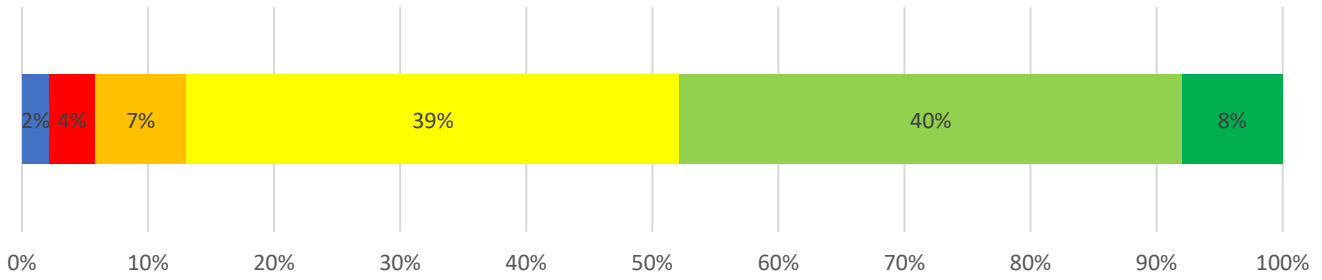
## ABOUT THE VILLAGE

- Residents were asked for their views on five aspects of village life, and how they would rate each aspect on a five-point Likert scale of Very Poor, Poor, OK, Good and Very Good.
- If greater than 40% of responses are Good or Very good, this is indicative of an overall positive view, and coincidentally where greater than 40% of responses are Poor or Very poor this is indicative of an overall negative view.

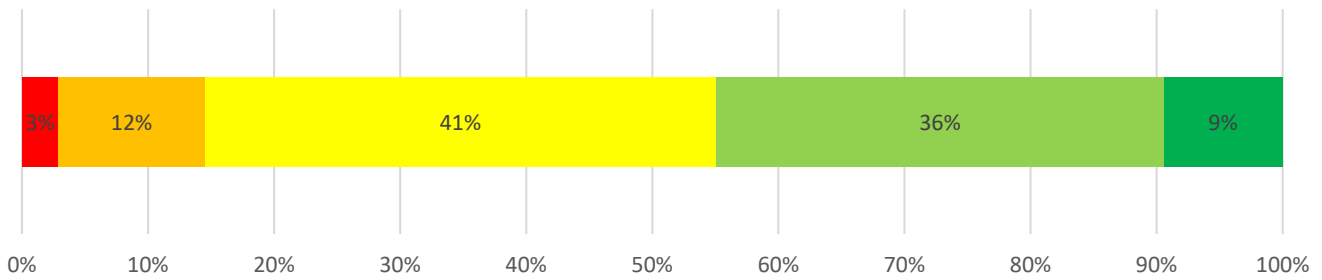
### How do you rate quality of life in the village?



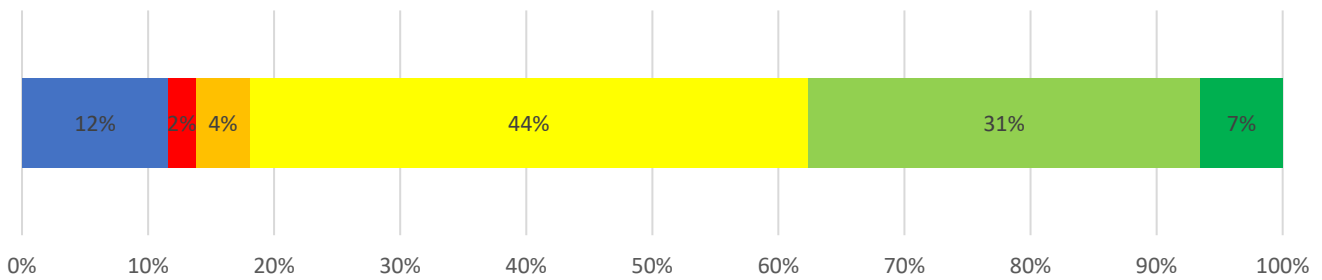
### How do you rate community activities within the village?



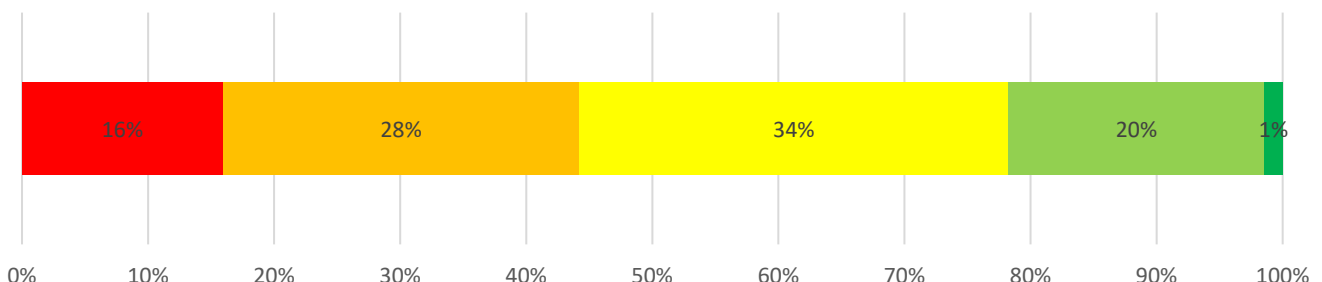
### How do you rate community facilities within the village?



### How do you rate the Play Park?



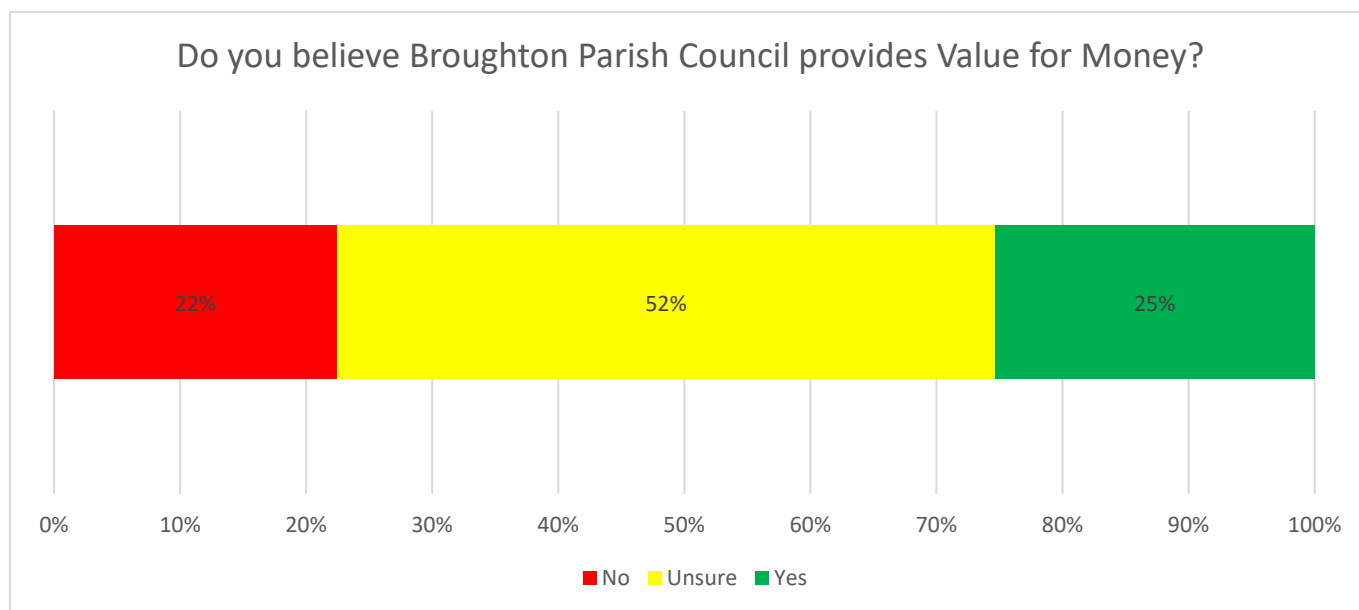
### How do you rate the tidiness and cleanliness of the village?

## VALUE FOR MONEY

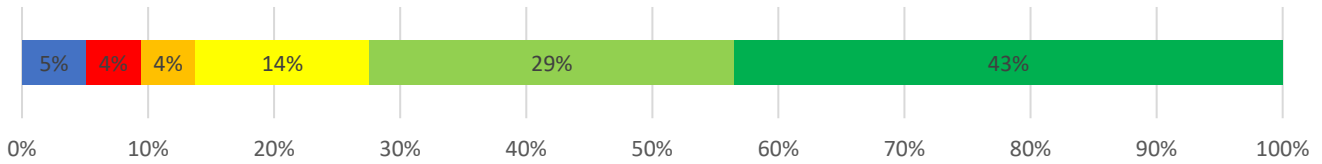
- The overall response was balanced, with the predominant view being 'unsure'. This demonstrates a challenge for the Parish Council to visibly demonstrate how it provides value for money.
- This does not necessarily mean keeping the precept as low as possible but providing services to villagers that are valued at a price point which is considered acceptable.



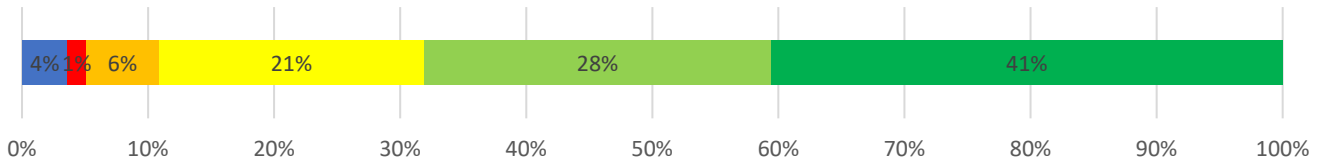
## ISSUES

- Residents were asked for their views on seven issues, and how they would rate each issue on a five-point Likert scale of importance – Not at all important, Somewhat important, Important, Very important, Extremely important
- The priority issues for villagers are: Improving Public Transport, Improving Traffic Calming Measures, Improving Facilities and Activities for Young People and Improving the Appearance of the Village.
- Medium priority issues are Improving Facilities and Activities for Older People and Improving the Play Area on the Welfare Field.
- Whilst Public Transport and Traffic Management are not the responsibility for the Parish Council, these findings can be relayed to the local Cumberland Councillor for Dearham and Broughton for information.
- The Parish Council can directly influence improving provision of facilities for young people and improving the appearance of the village.
- It is noted that some confusion was noted on the "New Housing Provision and Planning" responses with some uncertainty whether this referred to allowing new builds or a wider more general issue.
- Respondents with household members under 18, that improving the Play Area is rated at 55% Extremely Important and 36% Very Important, but this accounts for only 11 responses.

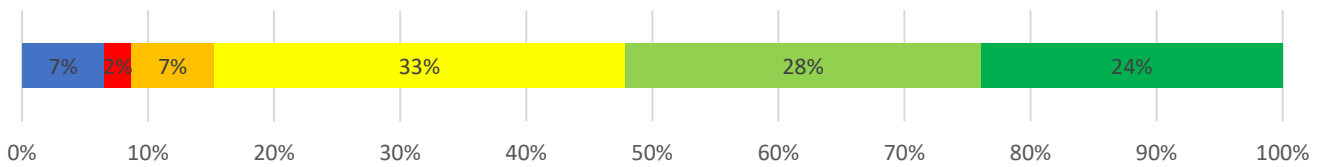

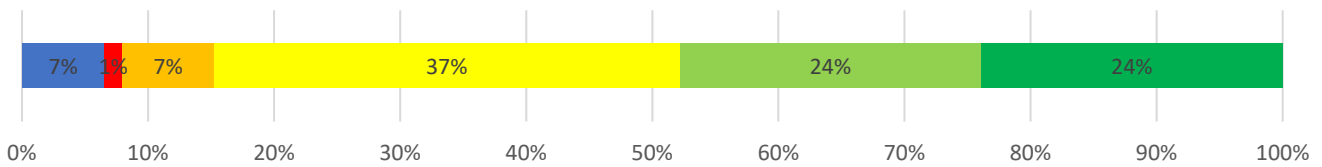

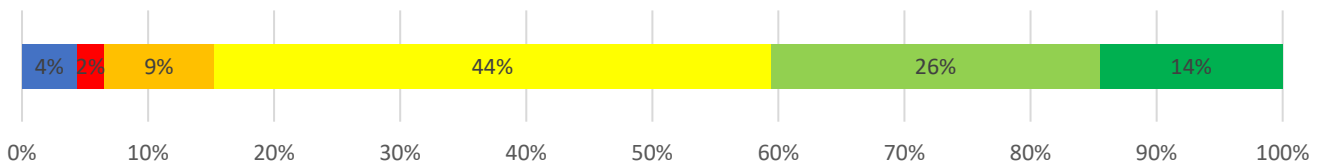

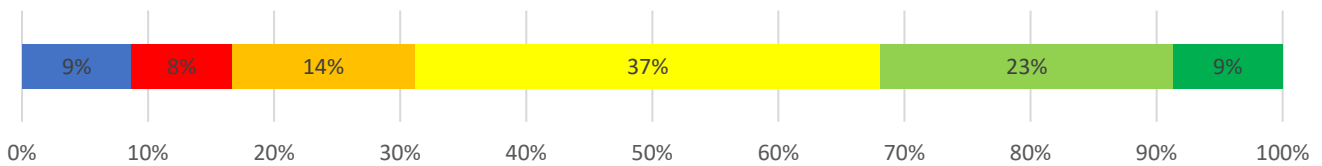

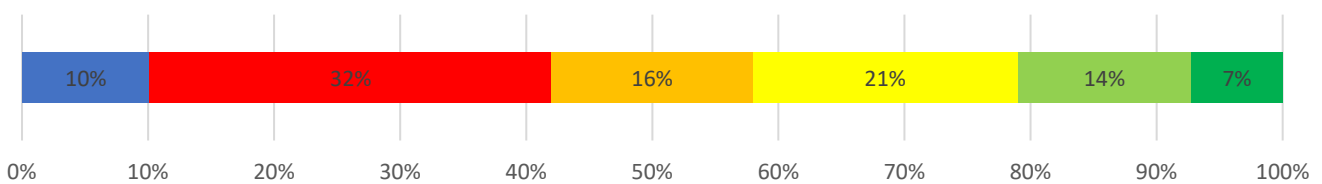

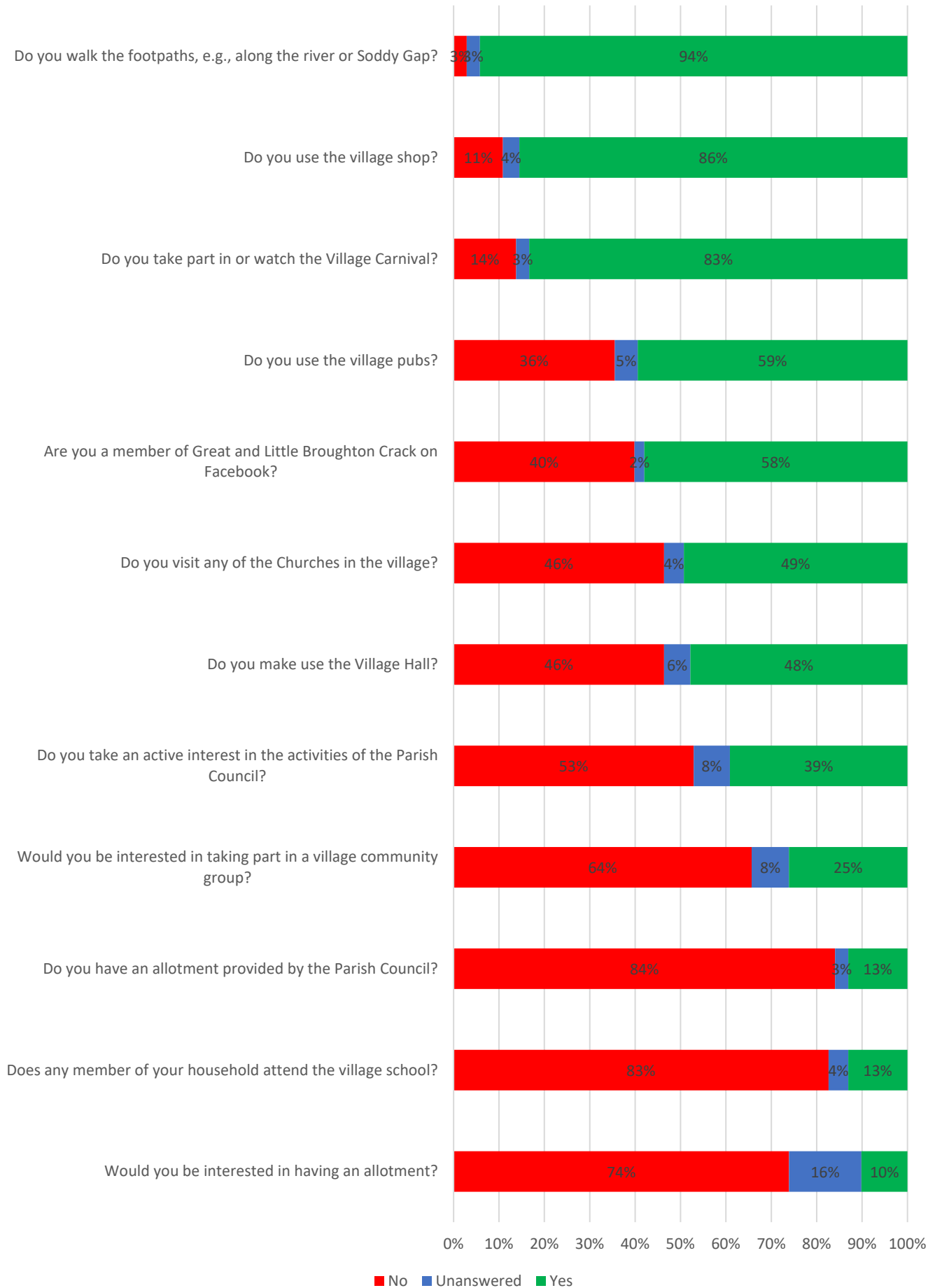

# WHAT ONE IMPROVEMENT WOULD YOU LIKE TO SEE DATA ANALYSIS

## WHAT IMPROVEMENT WOULD YOU LIKE TO SEE DATA ANALYSIS

- The Broughton Parish Survey provided two opportunities for written feedback from residents, asking “What one improvement would you like to see in the village?” and for “Comments and Questions”. These Results include analysis of the qualitative data obtained from the question “What one improvement would you like to see in the village?”.
- A word cloud, demonstrating the frequency of particular words which are repeated in raw unformatted text, has been generated from the data obtained and is provided below. This demonstrates that parking, traffic, dogs, litter and speed are the most mentioned words in the raw text (noting that the word dog was combined with several derivatives indicating dog mess)



- This word cloud analysis aligns with the detailed analysis undertaken of the categorisation of particular improvements, with the top six improvement categories being Traffic Calming, Litter, Facilities, Parking, Dog Mess and Public Transport.

- 31 distinct parish council actions have been identified from this analysis, with the top six actions being:
  - Feedback Highways concerns to Cumberland Council (relating to parking, traffic calming and other highways concerns)
  - Potential to recruit a village handyman (relating to litter and other environmental improvements such as weeding)
  - PC to organise regular litter picks (relating to litter and other environmental improvements such as weeding)
  - Feedback Street Cleaning concerns to Cumberland Council and request additional signage and path stencils (relating to tackling dog mess)
  - Feedback public transport concerns to Cumberland Council and Bus Operator (relating to public transport)
  - Feedback Street Cleaning concerns to Cumberland Council (relating to litter and other environmental improvements such as weeding)
- The vast majority of improvements suggested would be the responsibility of Cumberland Council, with 103 of the improvements suggested being their ultimate responsibility (66%), with the Parish Council only ultimately responsible for 25 of the improvements suggested (15%).

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## **METHODOLOGY**

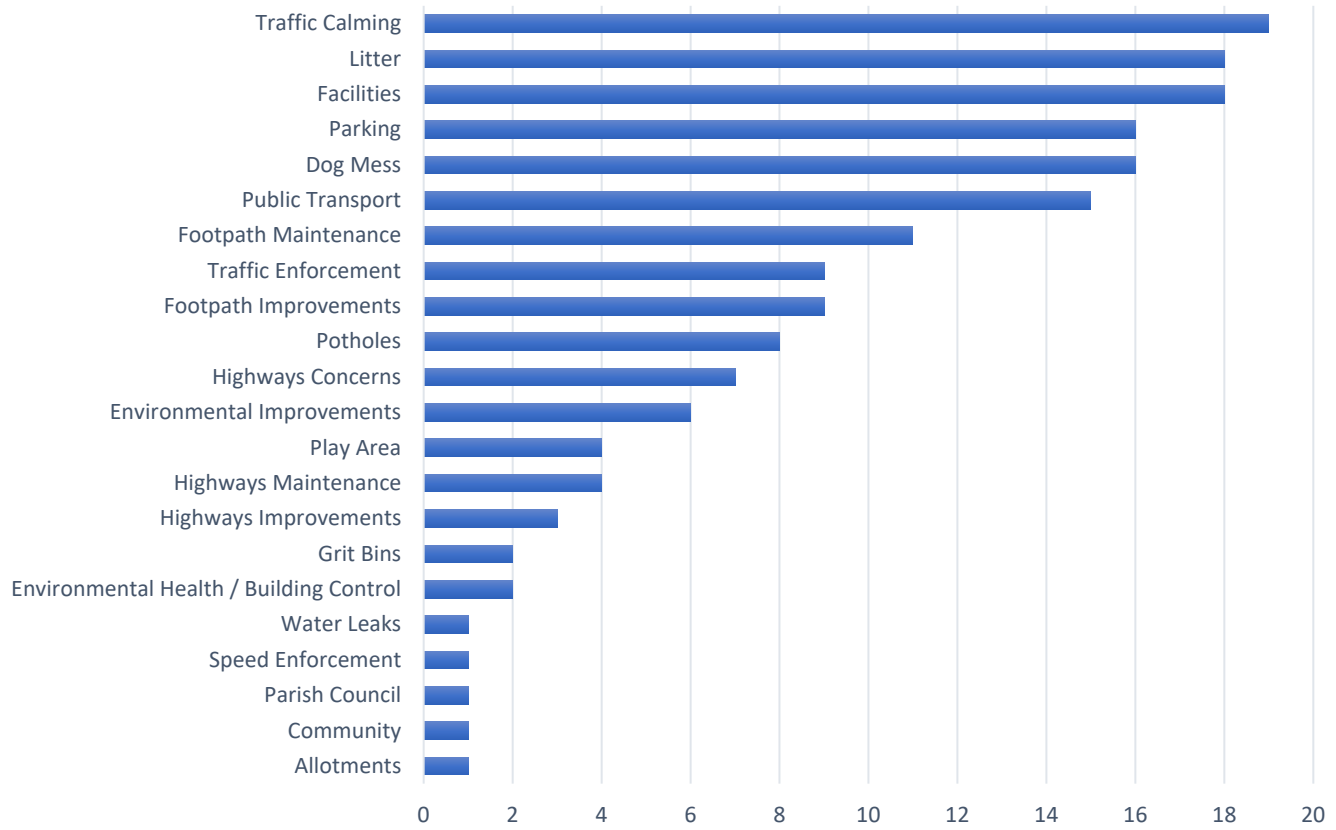
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### **Data Analysis**

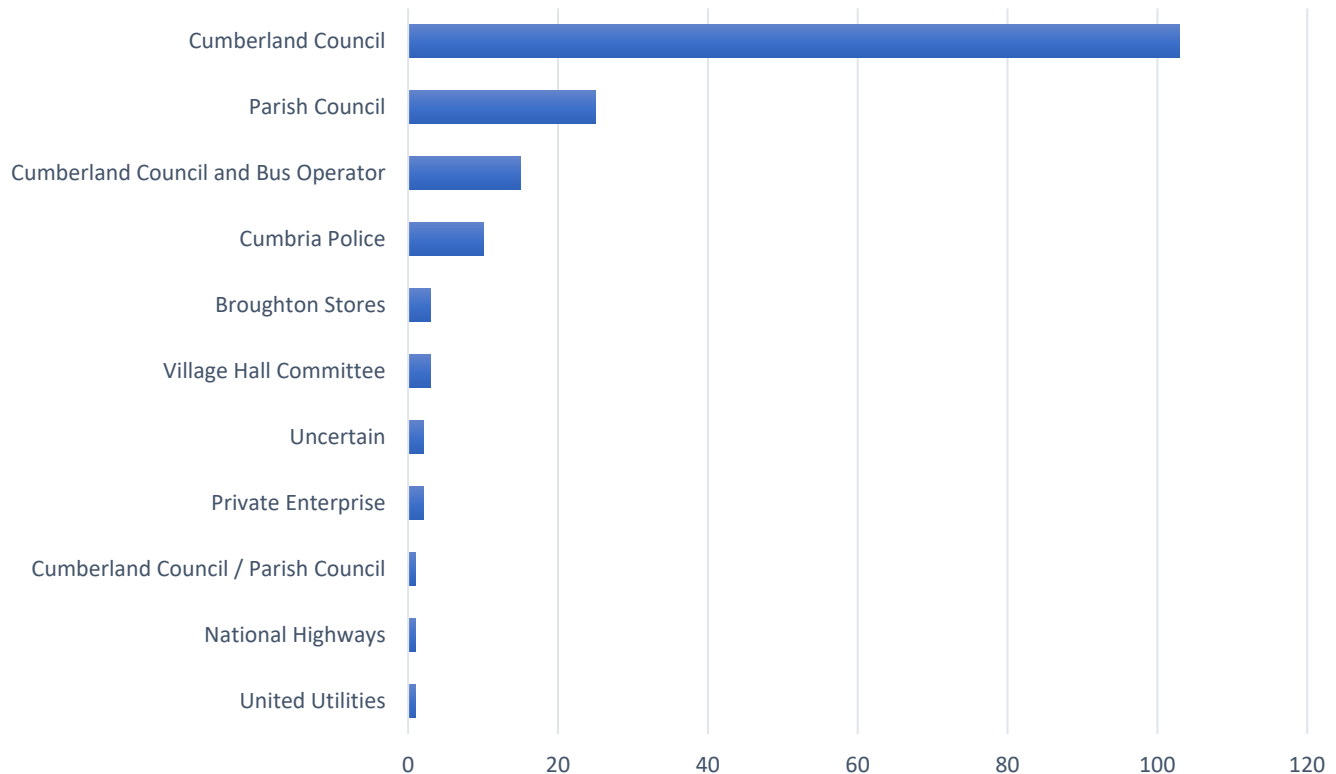
- Each handwritten comment has been copied verbatim, except for minor spelling corrections.
- These comments have been categorised against 22 categories, defined from themes emerging from the data.
- For each comment, a determination has been made for the authority or body corporate ultimately responsible for the suggested improvement raised.
- A suggested Parish Council action has been made for each suggested improvement raised.
- This method of categorisation has facilitated quantitative analysis of the qualitative data, enabling themes and priorities to emerge from the responses made.
- A crude method of quantification of word frequency analysis has been completed by using automated word cloud technologies whereby common used words (such as "and" and "the") are discounted from analysis, and the remaining words are given a larger font to resemble how frequent the word was mentioned in the raw text. This provides a visual indication of the responses given.

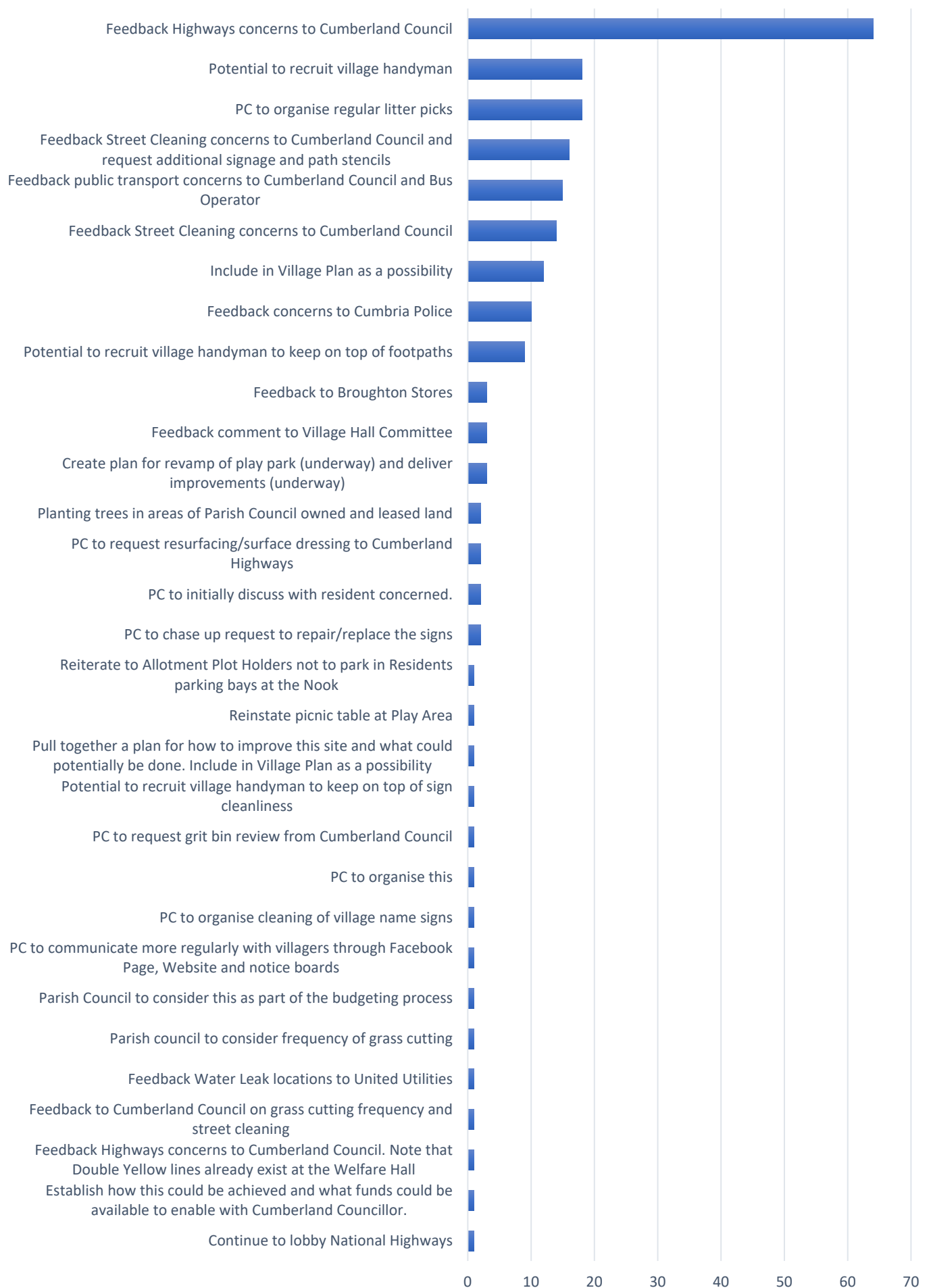
### Frequency of Categories of Suggested Improvements Made

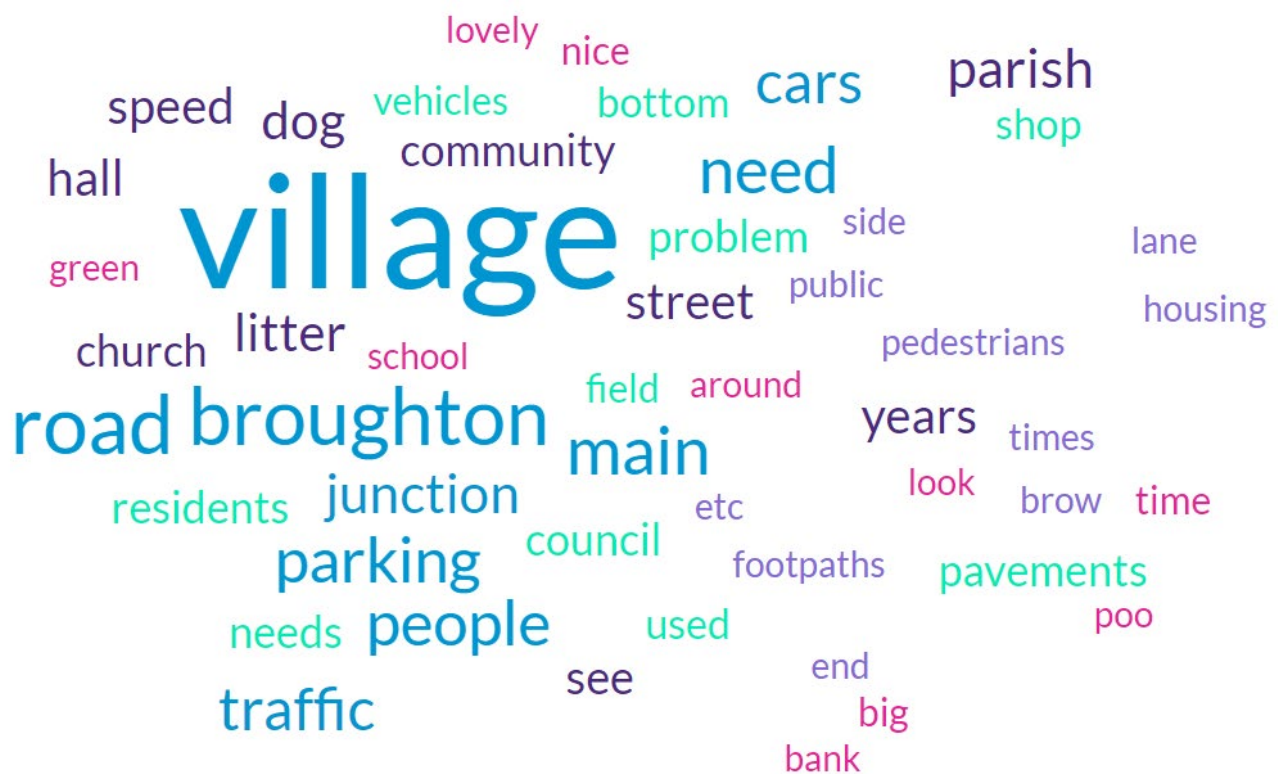

# COMMENTS AND QUESTIONS DATA ANALYSIS

## COMMENTS AND QUESTIONS DATA ANALYSIS

- The Broughton Parish Survey provided two opportunities for written feedback from residents, asking “What one improvement would you like to see in the village?” and for “Comments and Questions”. These Results include analysis of the qualitative data obtained from the question “Comments and Questions”.
- A word cloud, demonstrating the frequency of particular words which are repeated in raw unformatted text, has been generated from the data obtained and is provided below. This demonstrates that parking, traffic, dogs, litter and speed are the most mentioned words in the raw text (noting that the word dog was combined with several derivatives indicating dog mess)



- This word cloud analysis aligns with the detailed analysis undertaken of the categorisation of particular improvements, with the top six improvement categories being Traffic Calming, Litter, Facilities, Parking, Dog Mess and Public Transport.

- 39 distinct parish council actions have been identified from this analysis, with the top six actions being:
  - Feedback Highways concerns to Cumberland Council (relating to parking, traffic calming and other highways concerns)
  - Feedback Street Cleaning concerns to Cumberland Council and request additional signage and path stencils (relating to tackling dog mess)
  - Potential to recruit a village handyman (relating to litter and other environmental improvements such as weeding)
  - PC to organise regular litter picks (relating to litter and other environmental improvements such as weeding)
  - Feedback concerns to Cumbria Police (relating to speeding and traffic violations)
  - Feedback Street Cleaning concerns to Cumberland Council (relating to litter and other environmental improvements such as weeding)
- The majority of improvements suggested would be the responsibility of Cumberland Council, with 77 of the improvements suggested being their ultimate responsibility (40%), with the Parish Council ultimately responsible for 57 of the improvements suggested (29%).

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## **METHODOLOGY**

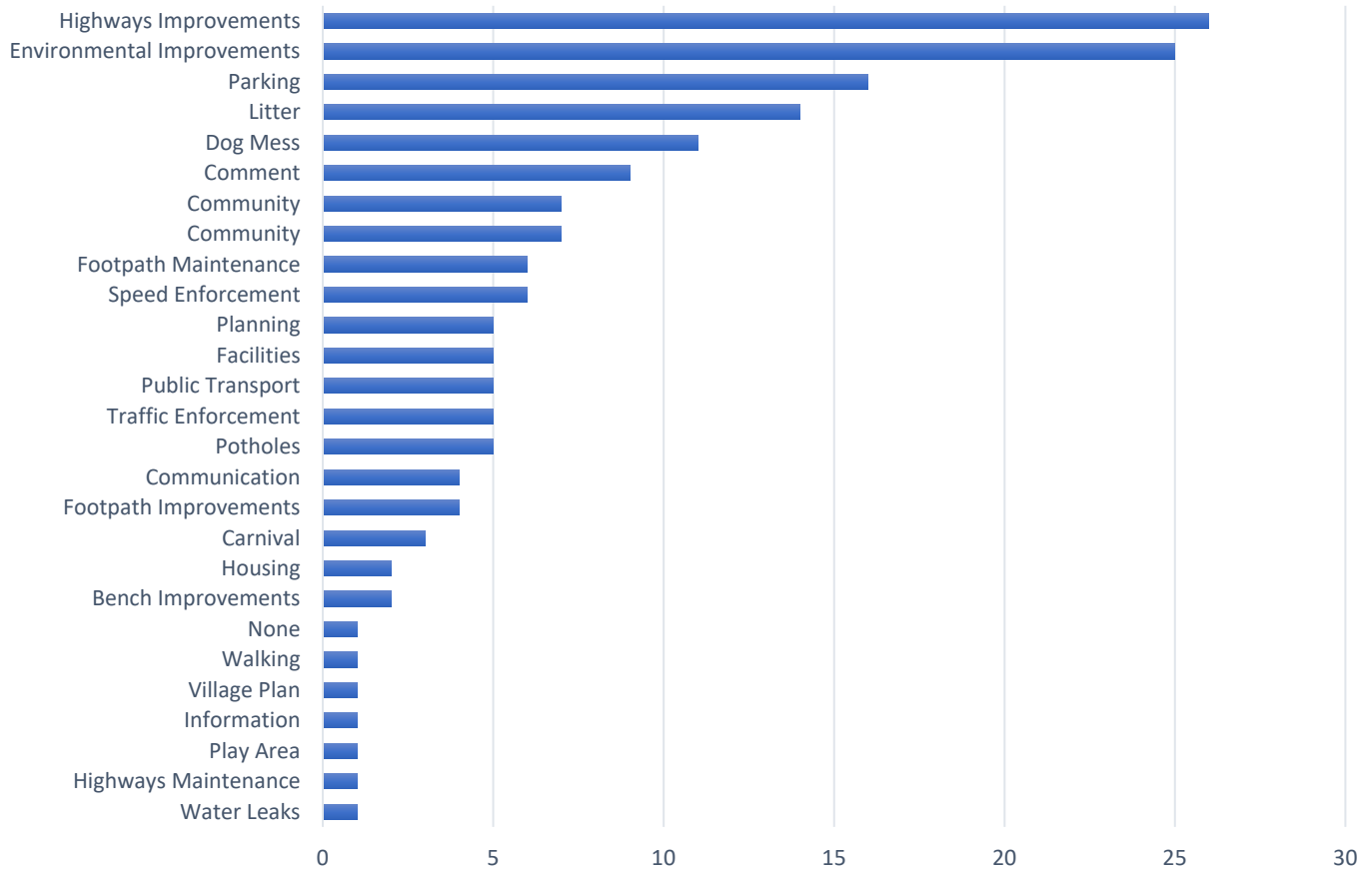
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### **Data Analysis**

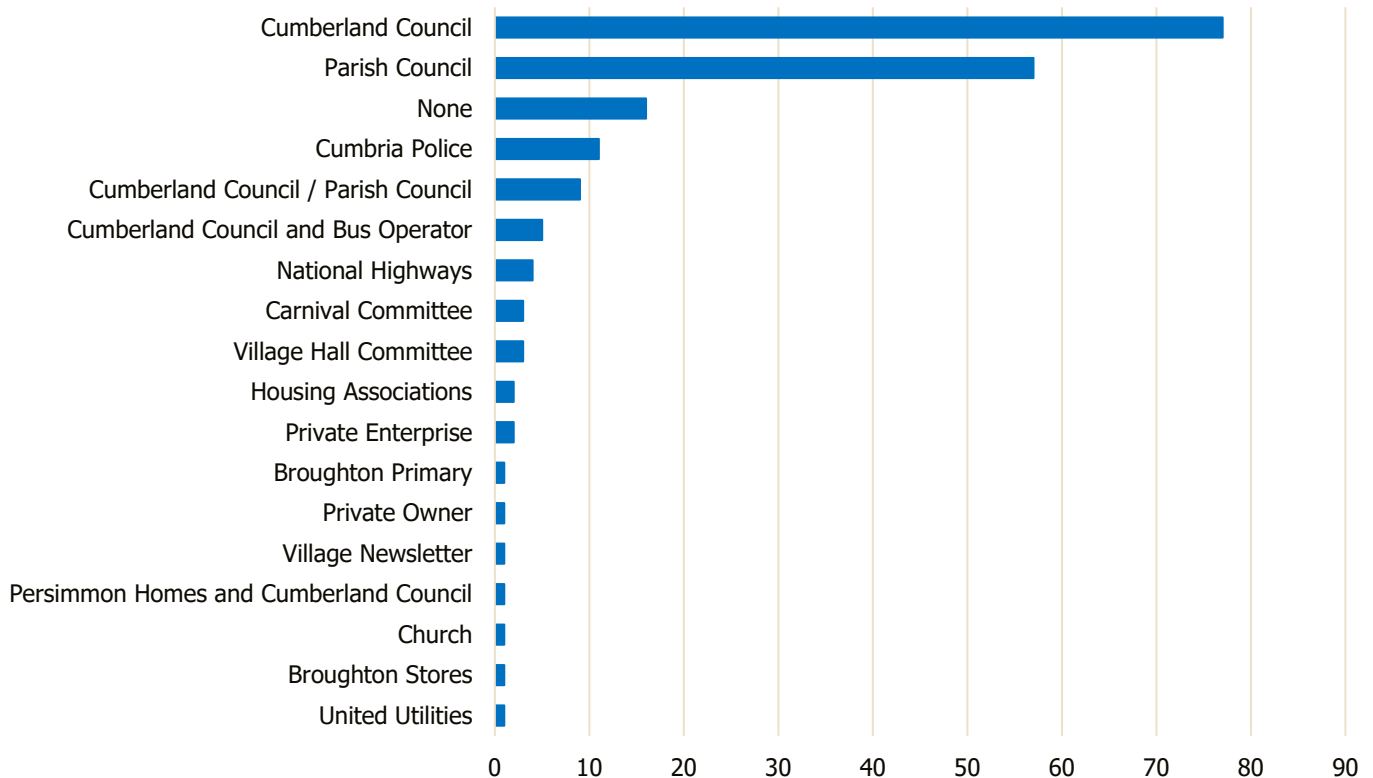
- Each handwritten comment has been copied verbatim, except for minor spelling corrections.
- These comments have been categorised against 27 categories, defined from themes emerging from the data.
- For each comment, a determination has been made for the authority or body corporate ultimately responsible for the suggested improvement raised.
- A suggested Parish Council action has been made for each suggested improvement raised.
- This method of categorisation has facilitated quantitative analysis of the qualitative data, enabling themes and priorities to emerge from the responses made.
- A crude method of quantification of word frequency analysis has been completed by using automated word cloud technologies whereby common used words (such as "and" and "the") are discounted from analysis, and the remaining words are given a larger font to resemble how frequent the word was mentioned in the raw text. This provides a visual indication of the responses given.

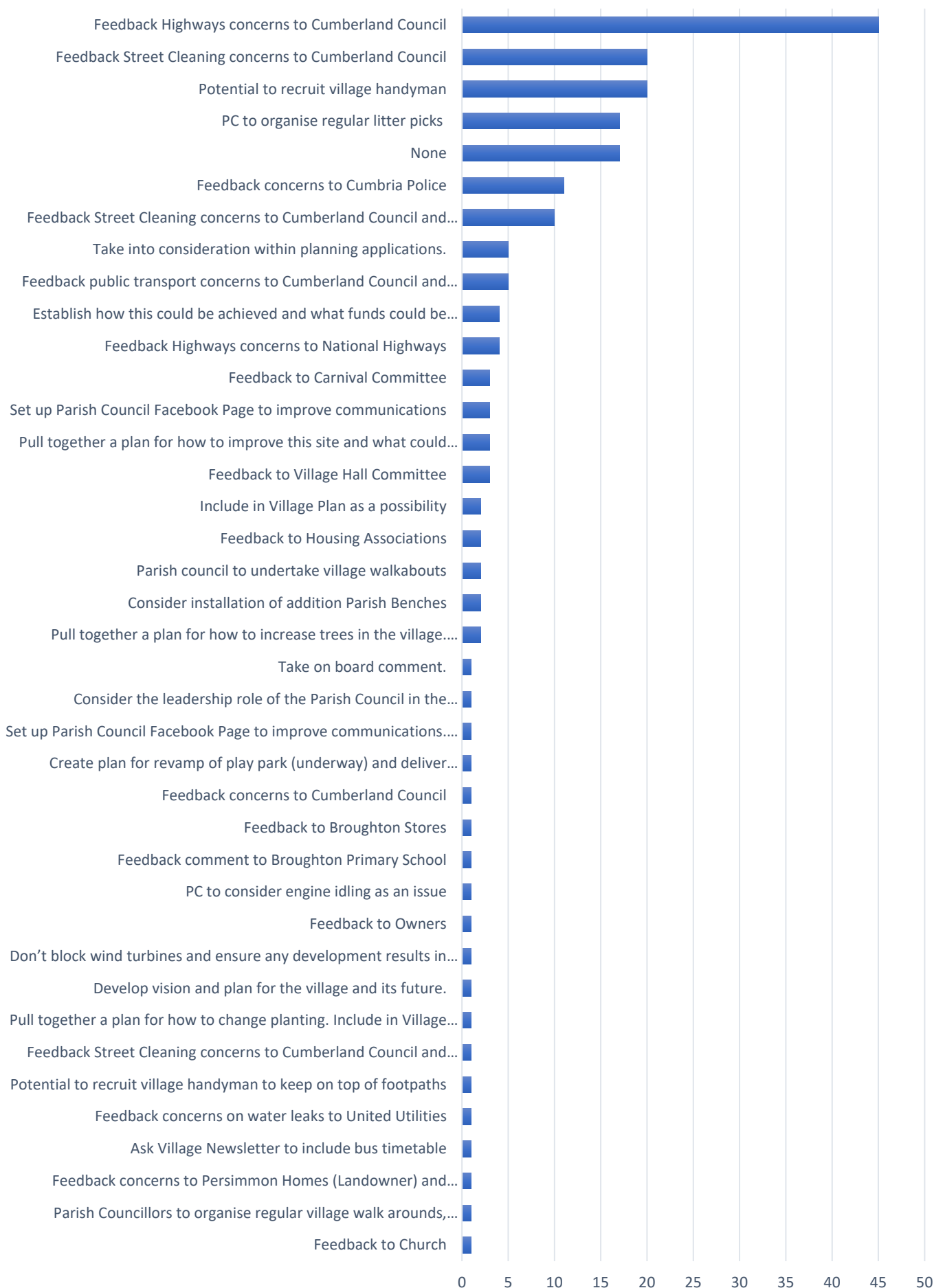
### Frequency of Categories of Suggested Improvements Made
